

From the south: Take I-5 north to Mission St./Hwy. 22 Exit #253. Turn left onto Mission. Proceed on Mission to Liberty St. SE, approximately 2.5 miles. Turn right onto Liberty Street and left into underground parking just to the left of the entrance to the Grand Phoenix Hotel.


